the place. The pastrami is lean, tender and moist. Their burgers seem more like a steak. And the huge plates of French fries are so delicious you won't be able to stop eating them. The matzo ball soup was sublime, as was the Cobb salad. A real treat was their chicken-in-the-pot, a heaping serving of chicken with noodles, matzo balls and fresh vegetables. And the desserts are just amazing. We tried the flourless chocolate torte and the cheese-cake and loved every bite. The huge and overstuffed sandwiches run from \$6.75 to \$9.25. Other entrees run between \$12 and \$17.

Their kids' menu doesn't disappoint either. We brought along a one year old who gobbled up the penne with cheese sauce and sampled and enjoyed some of the adults' fare as well. The standard price for the children's menu is \$7.25.

The wait staff was efficient and went out of their way to be helpful. The place is impeccably clean. There's parking available and the venue is fully handicapped accessible. It's open for lunch and dinner. Pastrami King also has a deli counter.
